We are pleased to announce that *Axioms* is now inviting nominations for the *Axioms* 2022 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of axioms. All nominations will be assessed by an Award Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Humberto Bustince.

The Prize:

- CHF 2000 (Swiss Francs);
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Axioms* after peer review before the end of 2023;
- An engraved plaque.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Nominees must hold a PhD degree and be below 35 years of age prior to 31 December 2022;
- Nominees must have ground-breaking research and have made a significant contribution to the advancement of the field of axioms;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior researchers, research directors, or department heads.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

- Open for nominations: 1 October 2021;
- Nomination deadline: 31 December 2022;
- Winners announced: March 2023
